※ 1 Means that the municipality or prefectural government has found the original housing to be uninhabitable for a long period of time due to continuing danger caused by the disaster, etc. Such household will be treated as "completely destroyed" under the Act on Support for Reconstructing the Livelihood of Disaster Victims.

※ 2 In a large-scale disaster, a possibility that those who suffered half-destruction or large-scale destruction, or those who need to be evacuated from their homes for a long period due to the risk of secondary disasters or disruption of lifelines.

※ 3 In cases of disasters such as specified emergency disasters, publicly funded demolition may be available not only for those who suffered complete destruction, but also for those who suffered half-destruction or worse; however, residing in the original housing upon repair should also be seriously considered.

※ 4 In cases of large-scale disasters, it is likely that not only those who suffered complete destruction but also those who suffered half-destruction or worse may be eligible for residing. But there are certain conditions regarding the income level and rent must be paid.

※ 5 5,000,000 yen in the case of death of the main financial provider and 2,500,000 yen for any other family member. In the case of severe disability, half of each such amount.

※ 6 In case of injury suffered by the head of the household requiring treatment for 1 month or more, and in case if damage to one-third of household goods (including damages by flooding), up to 1,500,000 yen can be borrowed.
